

In what countries does CNEWA work and how does the organization help those most in need?

Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) works across the Middle East (Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine, Syria), Northeast Africa (Egypt, Eritrea and Ethiopia), India and Eastern Europe (Ukraine, Armenia, and Georgia). CNEWA accompanies the Eastern Catholic Churches in these countries and supports the local Christian communities and those most in need through the service of our church partners, which include religious sisters, priests, volunteer lay people and various Christian institutions.

What is your vision for CNEWA Canada moving forward?

My vision is aligned with CNEWA's mission of working with Eastern Catholic churches to identify needs and implement solutions. I trust that CNEWA will have an even more significant impact on childcare initiatives, care for the marginalized, emergency relief, and healthcare programs for the years to come. At the same time, I hope that CNEWA will have a greater impact in fortifying the local churches and their pastoral initiatives for refugees, displaced peoples and migrants, youth formation programs, catechesis, and Bible camps. 
