So, it is not the monastic habit that makes the monk, but the fact that the monk seeks God alone and seeks to live in God's Presence always and everywhere.

Anyone who seeks God alone and lives in God's presence always and everywhere can be rightly called a monk! According to this definition, even a homemaker, a doctor, a farmer or someone who lives in the world can be a monk.

We are a community of monks in the world. With the exception of the monks of the fourth branch, everyone in the CFD (Community of the Sons and Daughters of God) lives in the world, not in monasteries.

Our mission is to evangelize. Not by preaching. Not by doing any special kind of work. But by a presence.
