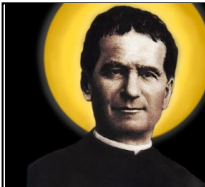

Saint John Bosco is a jewel in our history, a model of piety and a ferocious warrior against the enemies of the One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church. In the videos on this YouTube Channel, we'll attempt to analyze all the facets of his pious life. Prophet, diplomat, miracle worker, counselor, visionary, devotee of Our Lady, prolific writer, role model for wayward boys, founder of the Salesians, priest, warrior against heresies... It all can be summed up by the phrase, "Christianus alter Christus" -- he was Christ-like. He's the patron saint of apprentices, editors, publishers, teachers, schoolchildren, magicians, and poor and abandoned youth. An attempt was made by the Salesians to document his daring deeds for Christ, which resulted in a 19 volume biography. This Salesian treasure is the primary resource for our channel. St. John Bosco is a veritable font of interesting anecdotes and inspiring stories. The more we learn of and admire the saintly aspects of Don Bosco, the more we'll be like him in our own lives.
