Welcome Fr. Sean McEwen: our new Pastor.

Fr. Sean McEwen is from Halifax, Nova Scotia. After completing High School and a University degree in Halifax, he met the Salesians and was introduced to the charism of St. John Bosco through their Lay Mission Programme based out of New York. He served on two different occasions in this programme where he was missioned to West Africa and later to South America. Shortly after serving on his last Lay Mission experience, he discerned his vocation to religious life and entered into the



Salesian Society. He made his novitiate and first profession in 2004 at the Church of Mary Help of Christians in New York City. Following a few years of initial formation in New Jersey, Fr. Sean made himself available for the Missions and was sent to Southern Africa where he remained for 15 years as a missionary working predominantly in the Southern townships of Johannesburg. Having completed his theology studies at the Studium Theologicum Salesianum, in Jerusalem, Israel, he was ordained a priest at his home parish in Nova Scotia in 2012.
