## St. John Bosco Novena Masses

A Novena is nine days of private or public devotion in the Catholic Church to obtain special graces. The heart of any Novena is the same as the first one called by our Lord Himself (Acts 1:4). In this biblical account where the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary are gathered in the Upper Room after the ascension for nine days, Jesus commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father.



On the day after Ascension the Church often enters in to a Novena to the Holy Spirit, which culminates with the Feast of Pentecost. In our own day it is time to reach into the treasure house of the traditions of prayer within the Church and pull out treasures old and new. The Novena is just such a treasure.

Nine day vigils were noted in Church history from the third century onward. Still today, whenever we undertake a novena of prayer, we are declaring that same supreme desire to wait for the promise, persevering with confidence until the end.

Either as a public or personal observance, a novena involves nine days of hopeful anticipation of an answer for the petition or intention for which prayers are being offered.

There are a number of Novenas, most of which focus upon Mary, St. Joseph, the Sacred Heart, particular Saints, a special theme such as Divine Mercy or the Holy Family, or preparing for Special Feasts. Parishes often offer a novena of Masses.
